NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the **DONCASTER EAST INTERNAL DRAINAGE BOARD** proposes to carry out improvement works on the following watercourses in the Board's statutory district during 2025/2026.

Works will involve the de-silting of the bed and re-grading of the banks and access improvements on the above watercourses unless otherwise stated. All works will be carried out on one bank only which will be selected as necessary to minimise the environmental impact, following a technical and environmental survey.

The Board has undertaken an environmental appraisal and considers that the proposals are not likely to have a significant effect on the environment and does not, therefore, intend to prepare an Environmental Statement in respect of the works.
